I am writing to clarify the current situation with the collapsed part of Hythe Quay.

We, as the major local organisation representing those who live by or have an interest in the river side of Maldon, have had no communication with yourselves regarding the plans that we understand are being put forward by Maldon District Council and the timetable that is being considered.

I am sure you will appreciate that for a number of residents and businesses we are the first point of contact for disseminating information but we are being inundated for requests of information that we cannot answer. Therefore we would very much appreciate if you could help us providing answers to the following questions:

1. What are the plans for repairing the damage?
2. Are these of a temporary measure or would provide a permanent solution?
3. When is the work due to commence - not the current damage control measures currently being done?
4. How long will it take for works to be completed?

In addition, may we suggest arrangement of an open meeting for the Council to speak to the community.

Given the importance of Hythe Quay to the town, we believe that it is essential for the Council to provide a speedy and permanent solution that will allow the area to be again opened to the public.
